Scholarship Conditions:

1. Your visit must coincide with a field trip or symposium. In 2026, this will be held in around October/November in South Africa.
2. The duration of the visit is to be from 2 to 3 weeks. The dates and duration will be fixed each year after consultation with you and the South African region.
3. You must record your visit in detail as preparation for a presentation at the next IPPS NZ annual conference in Whangarei 2027 and as an article for the IPPS NZ newsletter and the Commercial Horticulture magazine.
4. You must endeavour to share your knowledge, skills and experience with your South African hosts.
5. You must remain as a paid IPPS member for at least 2 years after your trip.

Please note also to travel to South Africa you may need a VISA. You are responsible for gaining the appropriate visa/entry requirements 6 weeks prior to your departure date.
